HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

To be eligible for this scholarship, Applicants must enroll in a full-time undergraduate Engineering, Architecture, Interior Design or Construction Management degree program at an accredited college or university in the fall term of 2017. All applicants must also have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 basis) to be eligible to apply. No scholarship will be awarded for those pursuing an associate degree. Students attending a community or junior college must be enrolled in a program of studies designed to allow the student to transfer directly into a four-year program. Applicants who receive an appointment to one of the U.S. Military Academies (or affiliated preparatory schools) or are awarded a full scholarship at any accredited U.S. post-secondary institution of higher education are not eligible to receive funds from this program. A full scholarship is usually defined as one that provides for payment of tuition, books, lab fees, and other related expenses.

NOTE - Preference will be given to Engineering, Architecture, Interior Design or Construction Management curriculum that is related to the construction, operations, or maintenance of facilities, or in some way that supports America's Defense infrastructure. Preference will be given to candidates who are current individual members of the Hampton Roads Post, or a SAME Student Post at their college or university. Preference will also be given to candidates whose parent, guardian, or sponsor is a current member of the Hampton Roads Post of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) and/or a member of the National SAME. Detailed evaluation criteria are listed on Attachment B. The completed application, including transcripts, must be postmarked or e-mailed no later than 24 May 2017. Applicants are encouraged to go paperless and submit a scanned signed copy to the email address below. Otherwise, one hard copy of the application can be mailed to the address below. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
